I hereby declare that:

- that the National Association is a Full Member of the World Squash Federation (WSF) and is eligible to participate in these Championships;
- that we are aware of the WSF World Championship Regulations that govern these Championships and hereby agree to abide by all such rules and regulations;
- that our players shall participate at their own risk and not hold the Organisers, the Sponsor(s), the Host Association or the WSF responsible for any injury, disability or death arising from such participation.
- that we and our players understand that dope testing may be carried out on any or all players, coaches and managers.

The entry fee for the Championships is \$750.00 each person for players, appointed managers and coaches. Entry fees are payable in full by 30th September 2008. No entry will be validated without full payment. Entry fees may be transferred to another player if necessary but refunds will not be made.

NOTES

1. ENTRY

- THE CHAMPIONSHIPS WILL CONSIST OF MEN'S, WOMEN'S AND MIXED DOUBLES EVENTS
 - PAIRS OF PLAYERS MUST BE ELIGIBLE TO REPRESENT THE SAME WSF MEMBER NATION
 - ONE ENTRY PER CATEGORY WILL BE ACCEPTED AUTOMATICALLY FROM THE FIRST 16 NATIONS TO APPLY
 - RESIDUAL PLACES WILL BE FILLED BY LOTTERY OF NOMINATED SECOND PAIRS
 - IF PLACES STILL REMAIN THEY WILL BE FILLED BY LOTTERY OF NOMINATED THIRD PAIRS
 - FURTHER PLACES WILL BE FILLED FROM NOMINATIONS FROM OTHER THAN NATIONAL FEDERATIONS
 - After the final entry closing date, 15 September 2008, changes of players will be permitted up to 21 days prior to the commencement date of the Championships. After that time one member of a pair may be replaced by a substitute, but each pairing shall have a maximum of only one change and no change shall be made within one hour of the scheduled start of a match in which the pair will be competing.
2. The entry fee for each player and appointed managers and coaches is \$750.00 each
3. The entry fee covers accommodation in twin rooms for the nights of 14th –20th December 2008 (7 nights inclusive). The cost of breakfast is included in the entry fee but the cost of all other meals is the responsibility of the entrant.
4. Total entry fees must be paid before 30 September 2008 and entries may be cancelled if the payment is not received by this date.
5. All payments in US Dollars only and in favour of the World Squash Federation either by bank draft drawn on a bank in the United States or by direct credit transfer by Swift Air, with all charges payable by the drawer, to:

6. A maximum overall prize fund of US\$25000 will be distributed to players according to finishing order
7. Matches will be played best of five games, Point a Rally scoring to nine points, (with sudden death at eight all), on the increased width courts as approved by WSF in 2008.
8. All players must wear eye protectors which meet the requirements of the Rules of Doubles Squash at all times during play.
9. Clothing of players shall conform to WSF Championship Regulations, with each pair of players wearing identical shirts and shorts/skirts or dresses. Each pair shall have two sets of clothing in differing colours.
10. The Host Nation is: Squash Rackets Federation of India.
